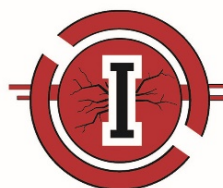

OPPORTUNITIES TO SERVE: We believe that God has designed Resurrection for you to engage in the many opportunities for you to **CONNECT** then **INVEST** in the ministry with your time and talents.

TEACHERS: Develop and deliver age appropriate messages from lessons, tying in an activity that will help the youth to grasp truth and interact personally with the children, demonstrating the love of Jesus for Sunday worship, midweek services and workshops.

TEACHER ASSISTANTS & AIDS: Use your gift and talent to assist the teacher in interacting with the children and youth, be prepared to encourage participation in the lesson. Help to maintain the order of the classroom during the session, help keep an accurate count of all children in the class.

PRAYER TEAM: Assist in praying for the children, students and parents at Resurrection, both campuses.

GREETERS: Welcome children and parents to the youth church services, midweek classes, Nursery or any other student ministry event. Guide them to specified area (designated by age groups) to the various rooms for the lesson and or activities (praise and worship, bible lesson, bathroom, medical attendant).

HOSPITALITY: Use your gift and talent to assist in the preparation and serving of food for the children at specified events. Set up the area prior to mealtime, serve and ensure everything is available throughout mealtime. Clean up the dining area afterwards.

MUSIC VOLUNTEERS: Use your gift and talent to assist the youth musical director in leading praise and worship and help motivate youth to worship Jesus in a number of ways. Assist all age groups in participating in praise and worship.

SET-UP/TAKE-DOWN CREW: Arrive prior to services and or events to prepare the classrooms, dining area, and praise & worship areas or event facilities for activities. Worship services will last approximately 75-90 minutes, events will depend as stated. Take-down crew will arrive 30 minutes prior to dismissal to prepare to clean up all areas.

COMMUNICATIONS: keep parents involved with ministry events. Gather and assemble information for the Student Newsletter, keep ministry calendar updated for parents and church webpage.

SOCIAL MEDIA: Use your gift and talent to help to maintain the Youth Ministry webpage, RSM Facebook, Twitter and Instagram pages. Assist in producing flyers and publications highlighting ministry offerings.

YOUTH ACTIVITIES COORDINATORS: are responsible for planning, coordinating and overseeing activities for students to promote fun, fellowship, spiritual development and ministry involvement.

CAMPUS MINISTRY COORDINATORS: are responsible for assisting in making sure that each campus is engaged with ministry functions, Youth Church, Midweek Small groups, practices, and special events.

VOLUNTEER COORDINATORS: are responsible for recruiting ministry volunteers for ongoing ministry and special events and outings.
