Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ):

What are Life Groups? Life groups are gatherings of people at least twice per monthly to fellowship, pray and discuss a specific topic.

What is the Goal of a Life Group? Life Groups provide an opportunity to better connect the body of Christ in order to grow spiritually, be discipled and strengthened as they do life together. We seek to transition our current RBC Group Life "ministries" into Life Groups.

How are Life Group <u>leaders</u> recruited? Recruitment is ongoing because <u>EVERY group needs a leader</u>! Potential Life Group leaders have an ongoing opportunity to self-identify their interest by emailing <u>lifegroups@myrbconline.com</u> and by visiting the church website, Life Groups page (once created). In addition, Life Groups will host recruitment sessions periodically throughout the year.

What is my commitment as a Life Group Leader? A commitment for at least the full length of a study is required.

How are Life Groups be formed? Via social media, church website, HiRez announcements, word of mouth, new members orientation and from existing groups.

How will people sign up for a Life Group? Members and non-members can sign up for a Life group through the church website.

Training:

What training will be provided for Life Group Leaders? Each Life Group leader will undergo training to equip them for their assignment. Training will be specific to the leadership role to ensure leaders are equipped to lead well!

How will Life Group leaders be trained? Life Group leaders will be trained via video, online and eventually in person as necessary.

Life Group Experience:

What type of Life Groups can one join? There will be life groups available for all stages of life including Couples, Men, Seniors, Singles, Women, Youth/Children and Young Adults



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What is a typical Life Group meeting schedule? Life Groups will be ongoing at least twice per month. A typical session will run between 40 – 90 minutes. A study can be four – twelve weeks depending on the focused study.

What will a Life Group study? Material will be found on RightNow Media or other resources within the framework of RBC. All curriculum will be approved by church leadership.

How will a Life Group study together? Online and in person. A Life Group Facilitator is trained to help each member experience both fellowship and study! When gathered, members will have a time of fellowship, reflection, prayer and connection with group members. This will be achieved by video, Bible readings and reflection questions created around the specified study.

Will there be opportunities to fellowship outside of the Life Group gathering? Yes. As the group bonds, it is encouraged that each group "do life together." This can be achieved by attending celebrations outside of the group setting, serving in the community together, visiting members who are shut in, etc.
