Jesus Did Not See Them.... Then Was Moved To Use Them... But... **JESUS SAW THEM... THEN WAS MOVED WITH COMPASSION...**

Compassion is the sometimes-fatal capacity for feeling what it is like to live in someone else's skin. We see this played out in the story of Jesus feeding the 5,000 in Mark's Gospel. In denoting Jesus' compassion for the crowds before He feeds them, the Greek verb indicates that He was 'moved in His innermost being or entrails', such was His ache for them. Compassion moves God to action, and it moves us likewise.
