STEP 01

"Leadership is a first a spiritual matter of the heart. Whenever you have an opportunity or responsibility to influence the thinking and the behavior of others, the first choice you are called to make is whether to be motivated by self-interest or by the benefit of those you are leading.



HEAD: What do you believe?

STEP 02

"The journey to leading like Jesus starts in the heart with motivation. Your intent then travels through another internal domain, the head, which examines your beliefs and theories about leading and motivating people"



HANDS: What do your actions say about you?

STEP 03

"You show what is in your heart and head in what you do with your hands: your motivations and beliefs about leadership affect you actions"
